Waterfront park closed during dredging

The park area on the Depot Slough waterfront in Toledo will be closed for approximately two weeks as dredging related to the transient dock is completed.

Port of Toledo General Manager Bud Shoemaker noted in a news release that the area will not be safe for pedestrian or recreational use due to heavy equipment traffic.

The contractor, Billeter Marine, of Coos Bay, is operating a crane with a clamshell bucket along the bank of the slough, then loading the dredged material into dump trucks, and driving around the park to unload the material in the recently constructed bermed containment area.
